Freelancer Gigs - On most of these web sites, small businesses, corporations, and individuals post **work they need** to be completed with the type of project, completion date, and the budget. Interested providers submit bids for the project to the requester.

On the other web sites mentioned, **freelancers list their skills**, expertise, offerings, and products. Then, requesters can decide who they want to complete the project work.

Full Employment Council (feckc.org) - This organization is a business-led private, non-profit corporation whose mission is to obtain public and private sector employment for the unemployed and the underemployed residents of Greater Kansas City.

The FEC accomplishes this goal by working in collaboration with businesses, local units of government, educational institutions, labor, and community-based organizations. It responds to regional employer needs while reducing unemployment, underemployment, and the public dependency of area residents.

The five counties that are served by the FEC are - Jackson, Clay, Platte, Cass, and Ray which are supported by seven offices located throughout this area. Only Missouri residents, or people who have recently worked in Missouri, can use this service.
